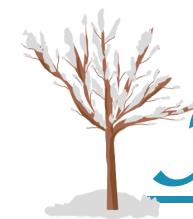
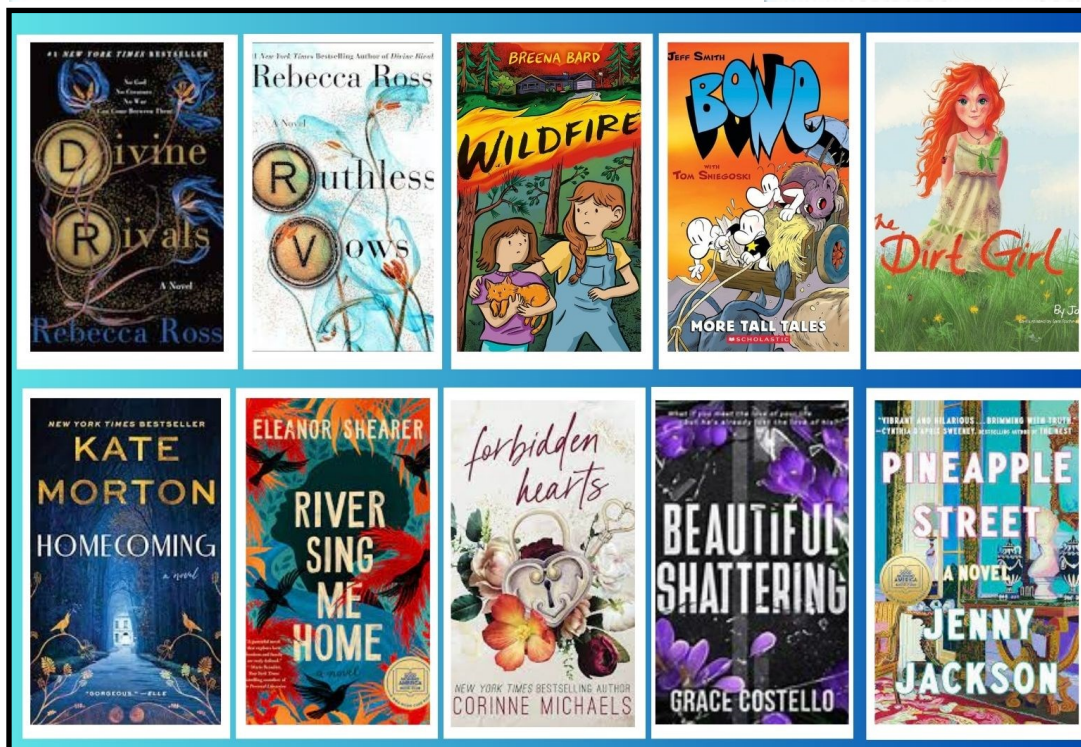

Council News

The Adams Community Benefit Plan Board will meet on February 5, 2024, at noon. They will be accepting grant applications for community improvement and benefit projects. Grant applications can be picked up at Adams City Hall and are due in by January 31, 2024.

The Adams City Council amended Ordinance #269 Regulating ATVs in the City Limits at the last Council meeting so the process of adoption will start over. The first reading is set for the January 8, 2024, meeting.

Ordinance #265-Livestock Ordinance was also amended and will have its first reading on January 8, 2024, meeting. If you would like a copy of the proposed ordinance, you can contact City Hall. Ordinance #265 will be posted in the Post Office as well. All City Council meetings are open to the public and you can also 'ZOOM' in. Guests attending the last Council Meeting had some excellent questions concerning the proposed ordinance. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact City Hall.

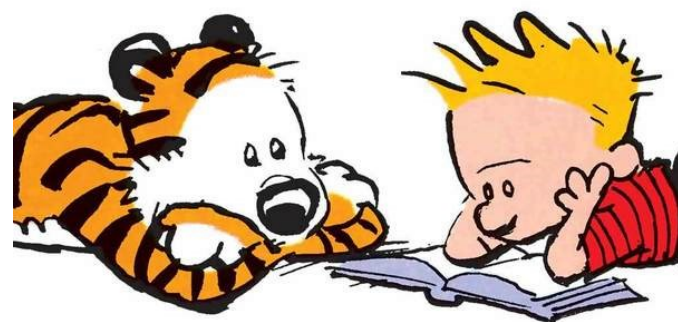
As the new year rolls in, so do new books! We have a fresh batch of new books in every genre as well as several recently released movies! Check out the back page to see some of our new titles.

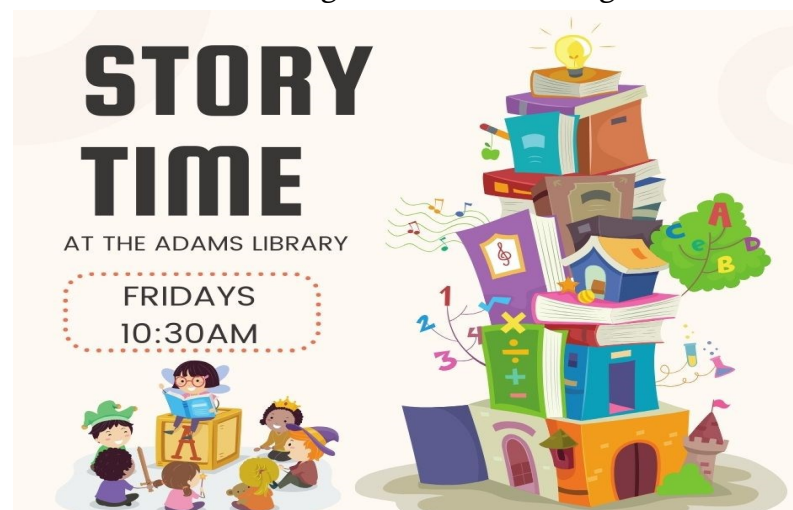
