




Daylight savings begins on Sunday, March 10! Can you believe it is time already?

Ordinance #265-Livestock Ordinance was given its first reading at the February 12, 2024, Council meeting. The second reading is set for the March 8, 2024, meeting. If you would like a copy of the proposed ordinance, you can contact City Hall. Ordinance #265 will be posted in the Post Office as well. All City Council meetings are open to the public and you can also 'ZOOM' in.

"Dumpster Days" is scheduled for April 25 through May 5, 2024. There will be signs posted at the containers detailing what is allowed and what is not allowed in the containers. Please be respectful and keep the items in the dumpsters, not on the ground. If the containers are full come back another day. We have them dumped as often as needed.

ADAMS DAY is set for Saturday, April 20, 2024. It is also the opening day for Triangle Little League. There will be vendors, a parade, and activities for the whole family. Dog license renewal is coming up in June. Residents have become non-compliant where their dogs are concerned. They are not licensing their dogs and supplying rabies vaccination certificates. Ordinance #236 outlines the rules for licensing dogs within the City of Adams. All ordinances can be found on the city website. Resolution #02-20 authorizes Municipal Court Fines and Resolution #03-06 establishes the fees for the licensing of dogs. All resolutions are viewable on the website also. The ordinances are very clear about letting dogs run loose in town.


