

On Sunday, November 5, 2023, we change our clocks back one hour to end daylight savings time.

The last water meter read of the season was on October 20, 2023. Residents are asked to pack their meters for the winter to prevent freezing. If a water meter is not packed and freezes, the homeowner is responsible for the cost of a new meter. Public Works Director Rich Stoupa is very close to having all the residential meters changed out. He is also still working to get the repair of the backflow devices scheduled.
