

City Council Workshop Minutes

September 5, 2023

City of Adams

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Graham Alderson at 6:30 p.m. Councilors Stephen Vorhauer, Jeff Rost, and Stephanie Partida were present. Also attending was Donna Grimes, City Recorder, Richard Stoupa, Public Works and Amanda Hespel, Librarian and Council Position #1 appointee, Lacy Heidenrich.

New wage scale proposals for Public Works, Librarian and City Recorder/Water Clerk were presented by Councilor Rost. Each position had three options presented with 10 steps at a 2% increase using current budget in Personnel Services.

- Public Works-It was recommended that the 'Easy Math Option" be used with Step 1 Base Salary set at \$20.50 per hour with a 2% yearly increase.
- Recorder/Water Clerk-It was recommended that the "easy Math Option" be used with Step 1 set at \$22.00 per hour with a 2% yearly increase.
- Employees would start out at Step 1 and the wage scale would become effective on October 1, 2023.
- Librarian-Wages are set by the Umatilla County Special Library District minimum.

The meeting was dismissed at 8:00 p.m.
